Do NOT equate BPs to mean PIPS. Totally different. My reference to BPs ALWAYS related to % of TOTAL NOMINAL ACCOUNT VALUE. A risk of 100 BPs means I am risking 1% of my capital on a trade. Taking a 100BP profit means profit = 1% of my total acct value

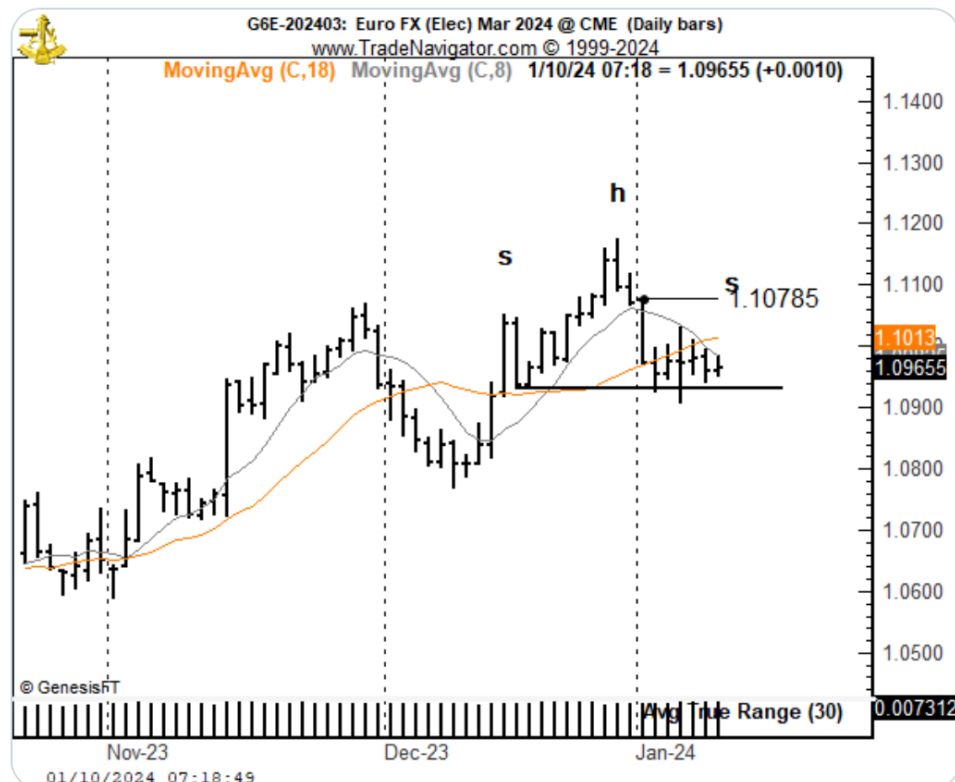

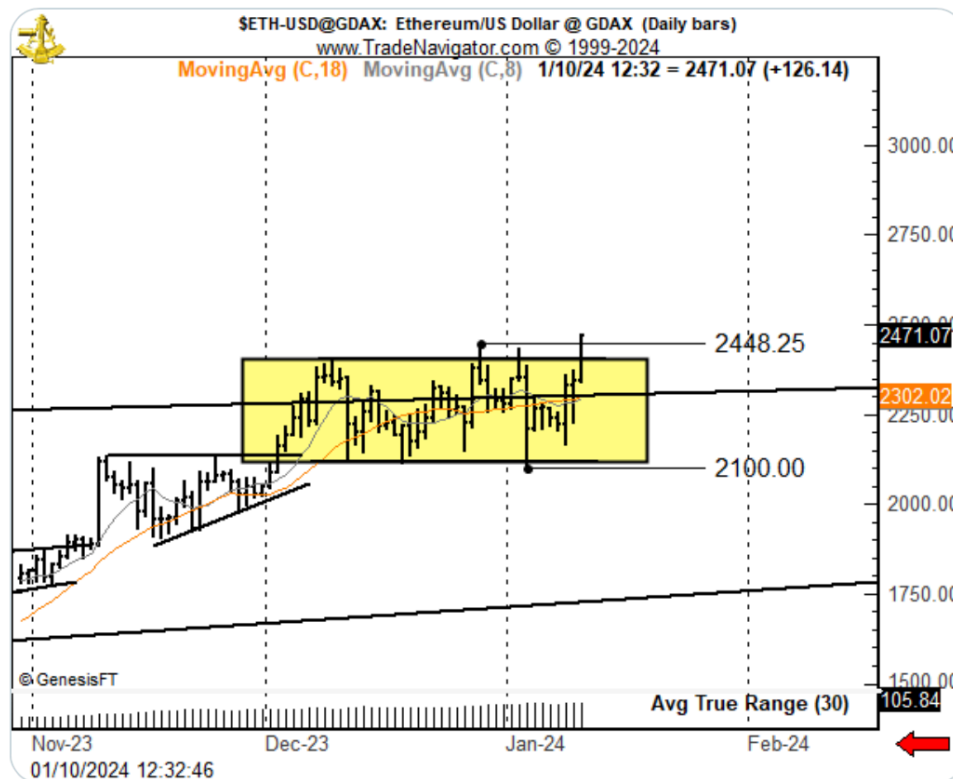




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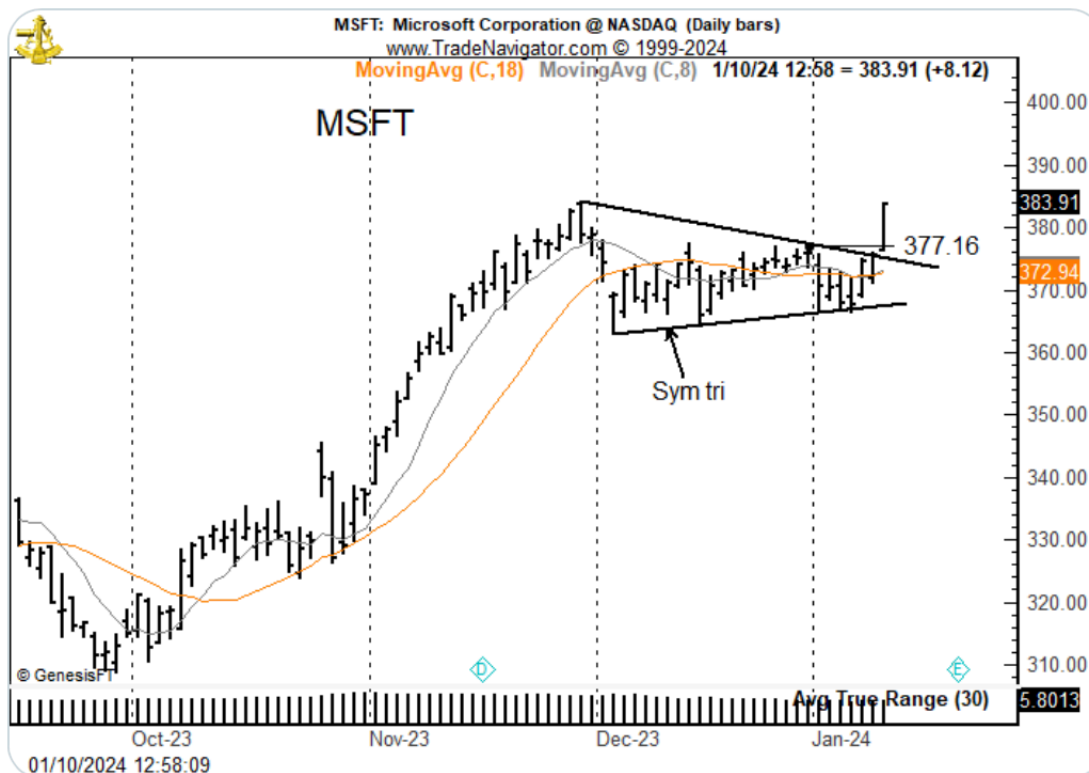
Darvas box????
